


WIRE FORMING INSTRUCTIONS






TYPE "A" EYE


Bend long end around tall pin in counterclockwise direction about 3/4 of a revolution (270 degrees) to form eye.




3. With short end engaged in grove, push crank toward head and turn clockwise at the same time. Continue turning crank until short end of wire is completely wrapped around shaft. You will hear a "click" when this occurs.

TYPE "B" LOOP





TALL PIN




2. Bend long end around tall pin in clockwise manner until it stops at short pin. Wire will spring back slightly.

3. Leave wire loop around tall pin and and swing back to right until long end hits short pin. Apply pressure to place kink in long end.

 Finished loop should look like illustration #4. To close this type of loop use a coil spring fastener.
